

I think the airlines should file monthly reports on incidents involving animals, and for the Secretary of Transportation to make this information available to the public so consumers can evaluate specific airlines' records. I would want to know this information if I were to transport any animal on an airline. I want to THANK you and urge you to finalize Reports by Carriers on Incidents Involving Animals During Air Transport AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE. But, the proposed rule only applies to pets of U.S. families (the legislation allowed for other animals - such as those destined for labs or zoos, and pets from other countries - to be covered), and I ask that the final rule define "animal" more broadly.
