

I am writing today to THANK the FAA for finally proposing a rule to implement "Reports by Carriers on Incidents Involving Animals During Air Transport". I urge the FAA to finalize the rule AS QUICKLY AS POSSIBLE. I am concerned, however that the proposed rule only applies to pets of U.S. families (the legislation should allow for other animals - such as those destined for labs or zoos, and pets from other countries - to be covered. I also ask that the final rule define "animal" more broadly. If it lives it deserves the right not to be frozen to death or suffocated. I appreciate everything the FAA is doing in this matter. I hope that in the end the compassionate decision will be made, not the one that benefits our wallets.
