Detailed Crash Report WY02111H271A is recorded as a State Reported Crash from the State of Wyoming. It was not a recordable accident as defined under 390.5 of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Regulations. This report is in error and may result in an erroneous Accident SEA Value

The ruptured tank did result in the vehicle being towed to have the fuel tank plugged and blocked off. The vehicle was then able to proceed under its own power. No other vehicle/s were involved and our vehicle did not strike any object other than running over road debris that could not be avoided by the driver.
