Please consider this a Request for Extension of Time for Comments to the above referenced Docket under 14 C.F.R. 11.29(c).

Petitioner, Aircraft Instrument & Radio Services, Inc., an FAA certificated Repair Station No. TI2R188L. Since this rule will greatly impact how we do business in the coming years and effect the way in which we comply with the FAR's, it is imperative we be given more time to review the proposed changes. The cost of doing business and added responsibilities is one issue, but when it comes to the safety of the flying public all due consideration must be allowed.

In addition to the above, Petitioner believes that good cause exists to extend the comment period to the maximum allowable on the basis of the FAA's own **observation** in the notice that this proposed rule has been under consideration for over 20 years.

This Proposal contains many changes to the requirements for the certification of repair stations which must be carefully considered. We must be given the opportunity to ensure that this rule will clarify any existing issues and clear up all old confusing issues and truly prepare us for the future. In the interest of the flying public and for the continued safety of all concerned, we feel that the maximum time allowed by law should be given to such an important issue as this.

Therefore, the Petitioner respectfully request the FAA extend its Comment Period, at a minimum, to December 31, 1999.
