
The Department of Transportation has received a memorandum dated January 22, 1993, from the Director of the Office of Management and Budget to agency heads. That memorandum directs Federal Agencies to withdraw certain proposed and final regulations from the Federal Register until they can be reviewed by appointees of President Clinton.

In accordance with that memorandum, the following documents scheduled to be published Monday, January 25, 1993 should be withdrawn from publication:

DOTIFHWA	Engineering and Traffic Operations: Highway Design Standards; Roadside Barriers and Safety Appurtenances; Federal-Aid Projects (Proposed)
DOT/NHTSA	Passenger Automobile Average Fuel Economy Standards for Model Year 1990; Termination of Rulemaking (Final Rule)
DOT	Organization and Delegation of Powers and Duties; Secretarial Succession. OST Docket No. 1 Amd. 1-253 (Final Rule)
DOT	Organization and Delegation of Powers and Duties; Secretarial Succession. OST Docket No. 1 Amd. 1-254 (Final Rule)
DOT	Alaska; Unfair Competition by Commonly Owned Carriers; Withdrawal (Proposed)

We are continuing our review to determine what other documents scheduled to be published at later dates are subject to the Director's memorandum, and we will notify you of any other withdrawals as soon as possible.
