Dear Madam,

In accordance with the provisions of Title 49, Code of Federal Regulations, Section 107.109, application is hereby *made* for renewal of Exemption Number DOT-E 11989 on behalf of the Department of Defense (DOD) for a period of two years.

This exemption authorizes the stowage of certain 1.1, 1.2 and 1.4 explosives, in the same freight container with Compressed Helium, a division 2.2 material on board vessels of the United States Air Force's afloat Prepositioned Fleet (APF). This exemption provides no relief from any regulation other than as specifically stated,

This is to certify that the descriptions, technical information, safety assessments, and **the emergency** response plans submitted in the original application remain accurate and correct.

Since the last renewal, 180 shipments **were** made under the terms of this exemption. No accidents or incidents resulting in loss of product have been encountered.
