

It is astounding that anyone would consider blowing train horns through town at all hours of the night, just because there is one chance in a million of some sort of danger.

People living in towns in which the railroad passes cannot sleep at night with the train horns blowing continuously. There must be no horn blowing between 11:00 PM to 6:00 AM or the health of the populations near the tracks will be endangered from loss of sleep.
