

Please note that the law passed by Congress mandates that all charter operations (both large and small) must comply with the law stating that public charter operations using aircraft with more than 9 passenger seats MUST operate at certified airports only!


For the FAA Regulators to propose regulations clearly contrary to the law, it's intent and the mandate of congress would be arrogant, audacious and a clear abuse of power.

The regulations and rules should enforce the 9-passenger seat limit, so that all planes with scheduled aircharter operations and more than 9 passenger seats must use Certificated Airports only.
