

Consideration should be made for the use of a military type hard card for each piece of life limited hardware. It acts as a birth cert. for the part and is created at the same time the part is certified airworthy. It has space for any removal, installation and pertinent maint. performed on the part for the life of the part. The part and the card stay together from mfg until scrapping of the part. This system works very well as long as the rule states: "Without the history card the part is scrap". Strict rules for re-creating the history card, for cases of missing or lost cards would have to be a part of the same rule. This is a full proof method of tracking the life of a part and would fit any records keeping system.
