I would like to make the following comments on the National Parks Air Tour Management Proposed Rule. First, I believe that the 5000 ft. AGL is a little excessive. I think that a lower AGL, perhaps 2000 or 3000 ft., would accomplish the goal of reducing noise without placing sightseers almost a mile away from visual objects.

Next, there needs to be some kind of exclusion for Grand Teton National Park, since there is a commercial airport within the National Park that these sightseeing tours might originate from.
