

I write in support of the formal comments submitted by the National Parks Conservation Association. In addition, I urge FAA and NPS to work closely together to enact at the earliest possible time relevant provisions in the Glacier National Park General Management Plan, which called for a ban on commercial sightseeing air tours over the park. This was in response to overwhelming public concerns about the inappropriateness of noisy commercial helicopter flights over the Glacier wilderness. I have personally experienced the rude intrusion of commercial helicopter overflights in Glacier, and share the broad public sentiment that they do not belong over Glacier. Please keep me informed as this rulemaking process moves forward.
