
Gentlemen:

My wife and I would like to take this opportunity to comment on the air tour management planning process over national parks. Document No. FAA7200178690.

National Parks are special places in our country, set aside for the preservation of their natural features and for human enjoyment. We feel that having a quality experience takes a higher priority than the profits of air tour companies that have the potential to degrade a visitor's experience.

1. We would suggest that air tour operators stay 5,000 feet above ground level.
2. There should be enforcement of the altitude restriction by the FAA.
3. There should be no new air tour operators allowed while the air tour management planning is being developed.
4. Clearly define how the air tour management plan will be developed.
