On April 22, 1996, representatives from American Airlines met with members of the the General Counsel's Office. Ms. Sylvia DeLeon, Ms. Ann MacNamara, Mr. Davis Schwarte, and Mr. Gary Doernhoefer attended on behalf of American.

American expressed its desire to have its application for antitrust immunity in Docket OST 95-792 and all other pending applications for antitrust immunity processed by the Department in the order in which they were filed, and explained briefly why its application merits such treatment. American also expressed its opinion that all pending antitrust applications should be treated in a similar fashion, including the imposition of conditions.

We thanked them for their views, but expressed no opinion on the substantive merits of the proceeding. We did, however, assure them of the Department's intention to ensure that our procedures are fair to all applicants.
