

If, under current law, individuals who use insulin cannot obtain a Commercial Driver's License (CDC) now, but a new plan under review will grant a license to insulin users on an individual basis if the individual has been driving while using insulin for three years, how are these people going to make a living during this period? This is a civil rights issue, because the three year stipulation adds a hardship to individuals who already suffer from a disability. Forcing even newly diagnosed diabetes cases to possibly change careers, or wait three years to qualify for a CDL is an inconsistency that DOT should rectify.
