

The headlights that exhibit a blue coloration are extremely uncomfortable to view when coming toward you. There is a type of glare that is more obscuring than a normal headlight produces. The headlights which cause the fewest viewing difficulties appear to be the old sealed beam type. Also, multiple headlights active at night make it more difficult to see past the oncoming car. You may also want to look at the plastic lenses used on more recent cars. Many seem to be fogged over after a few years. This might produce more side glare than was originally present in the new car.
