

I have noticed that there has been an increase of oncoming headlights that are particularly bright and hinder my vision as I drive at night. I am in my early forties and my wife is beginning to experience the onset of "night blindness" which we describe as the pupils inability to adjust quick enough to brightening and dimming light sources. This is particularly hard in suburban settings where there are no street lamps. I think there should be a set brightness that all headlights can not exceed for low light setting as opposed to bright light setting.
