

In all likelihood none of the airports that this rule impacts have acquired automated fingerprint submission equipment, and it will be some time before they do. This new rule will have a significant economic impact on airport tenants in the interim. The turnaround time for manual fingerprint submissions is far too long. When the ASIA 2000 was passed, there was at least a provision which allowed airports the authority to grant temporary SIDA Access (45 days) for new SIDA applicants that had already undergone the 10 x 5 year employment history verification. This new rule will have severe cost repercussions for the aviation service industry unless the 45 day temporary SIDA Access is included in this new rule.
