To whom this may concern. I am a 4th grade school teacher in Cleveland Ohio. Yesterday one of my students asked me why her father has lost his job as an airline pilot. She said that her mother told her it was a new regulation that was put in place. I know the family and inquired about this new regulation. I am confused as to why a regulation was enacted without any regard to its effect on families of loyal Americans.

This regulation is unfair and I believe unconstitutional. A change needs to be made to allow current workers with long demonstrated ability to continue to live out there lives in the profession they have worked in over the last 20 years. This family should not be penalized for something they had nothing to do with.

What further troubles me about the regulation is that in this family's case the farther was expunged of his crime and is still unable to work.
