The above action was taken: January 15, 2003, and will remain in effect through January 15, 2005, provided that Northwest continues to hold the necessary underlying economic authority to operate U.S.-Philippine all-cargo service.

Except to the extent exempted or waived, this authority is subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations indicated: **XX** **Holder's certificates of public convenience and necessity**

Conditions: Consistent with our standard practice, the frequency allocation granted is subject to the condition that the allocation will expire automatically and the frequency will revert to the Department if it is not used for a period of 90 days.

Under authority assigned by the Department in its regulations, 14 CFR Part 385, we found that (1) our action was consistent with Department policy; and (2) grant of the application was consistent with the public interest. To the extent not granted or denied, we denied all requests in the referenced Docket. We may amend, modify, or revoke the authority granted in this Notice at any time without hearing at our discretion.
