

I'm appalled that my government is taking away my rights as a citizen to due process and my ability to work with the FAA and TSA adoption of FAA 2003 14293, Ineligibility for an Airman Certificate Based on Security Grounds.

This rule was adopted without notice or comment and would allow the FAA to revoke my commercial pilot license without any chance to challenge the basis for how a citizen/pilot might pose a threat to security. This rule could even make pilots afraid to speak out about security problems for fear that the TSA security police will charge that the pilots themselves are a threat and revoke their licenses. Moreover, while I'm subject to this rule the FAA, DOT and TSA allow foreign airlines, including those from Saudi Arabia and other Middle East countries to fly freely within our borders.

The FAA and DOT should revoke rule immediately, until they allow comment on a rule that will provide me and my fellow airman and citizens with due process to protect our rights.
