

Revocation of rights without due process is demonstrably unconstitutional, and decidedly unamerican. The definition of "security threat," if articulable, can be clearly stated and demonstrated in a court of law. If not articulable, then the threat cannot be considered grounds for revocation of rights. FAA-2003-14293 needs to be rescinded immediately. Further bypassing due process is yet another unsettling advancement in the erosion of liberty by an organization whose track record on the matter is, at best, marginal.
