I would like to comment on the proposed rule dealing with reducing noise from overflights of Grand Canyon National Park.

I firmly believe that:

- \* tour operators should be required to convert to the quietest technology available.
- \* it is imperative to restrict the number of aircraft that use the airspace.
- \* flight free zones should be just that, and that no aircraft, not even those placed in Category C, should be granted routes through these zones.
- \* the criteria used to categorize an aircraft's noise efficiency should be more stringent than those proposed.
