

AUTOMOTIVE LIGHTING, one of the biggest manufacturers in vehicle lighting worldwide is fully in favour of NHTSA's ideas with respect to replacement parts as long as technical improvements during the production period of headlamps and signalling lamps are permitted.

Products for installation on vehicles replacing and/or supplementing the original equipment to improve conspicuity of a vehicle and driver's night vision should not be prohibited as long as they are in compliance with FMVSS 108. This compliance should be certified by the manufacturer and regularly checked by NHTSA's enforcement. This is in AUTOMOTIVE LIGHTING's opinion the most reasonable way to keep irresponsible manufacturers/distributers out of this obvious lucrative market.
