The Air Transport Association hereby withdraws the petition filed on February 25, 2003, subsequently assigned to Docket No. 14594.

We do intend to file a revised petition in the near future. However, after further review, the petition incorrectly seeks to amend 14 CFR § 121.391. Because the subject of the petition addresses flight attendant staffing on the ground only, § 121.391 is not implicated. For the relief requested, only § 121.393 needs to be revised.

We recognize and appreciate the efforts of your office to respond to our petition and apologize for the inconvenience we undoubtedly are causing. We will file a corrected petition as soon as possible.
