

§ 659.23 Oversight agency safety and security reviews.

The rule should clarify as to what should be contained in the report of the oversight agency's safety and security review. It should include at a minimum the following: The oversight agency must prepare and issue a report containing findings, recommendations, corrective actions, and the transit agency's response to each finding that requires additional action and a time frame to implement the corrective actions resulting from that review, which, at a minimum, must include an analysis of the efficacy of the system safety program plan and a determination of whether it should be updated. The rule should allow the oversight agency the discretion to conduct on-site reviews more frequently than every three years.
