Section 6(a)(3)(E) of Executive Order 12866, "Regulatory Planning and Review," requires agencies to identify the substantive changes between a draft regulatory action submitted to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for review and the action subsequently announced.

Pursuant to OMB Circular A-4, "Regulatory Analysis," we added Chapters XI ("Sensitivity Analysis") and XII ("Probabilistic Uncertainty Analysis") to the Preliminary Economic Assessment (PEA) accompanying a notice of proposed rulemaking on side impact protection (RIN 2127-AJ10; 69 FR 27990). Conforming changes were also made to the Executive Summary of the PEA, as well as to Chapter V of the document.
