

I am writing to urge support in seeking approval for personal oxygen concentrators to be used on flights. Use of units like Inogen One or LifeStyle from AirSep would make flying so much more available to thousands of people who require oxygen. The way the system works now a patient is scared to try to fly for fear of not having the necessary oxygen waiting along the way for connecting flights and the need to have someone meet you with oxygen to use when you get to your destination. It really severely limits our travel.....and then, there is the factor of COST with each airline charging over \$100 for their leg of the trip. I would also like to urge that if this is considered to also allow the capability of tapping into the airline plugs as the battery life of 50 minutes is not adequate and if we could not use auxillary power the passage of the use of these units would really be null and void anyway. So I would like to see approval of use of the concentrators and the auxillary power. Seems to me breathing is a little more important than playing video games, listening to music or using computers and these units should be allowed to be plugged in.
