Every time I give a kid a ride, I would have to take his picture, get a copy of his birth certificate, and send this information in to the government. I guess this includes my grandchildren, or a whole bunch of relatives when I take all the kids up for a ride on Thanksgiving. Also, foreigners who already have American Pilot's licenses have already been checked, haven't they. If so, it seems like there should be an exemption for them.
